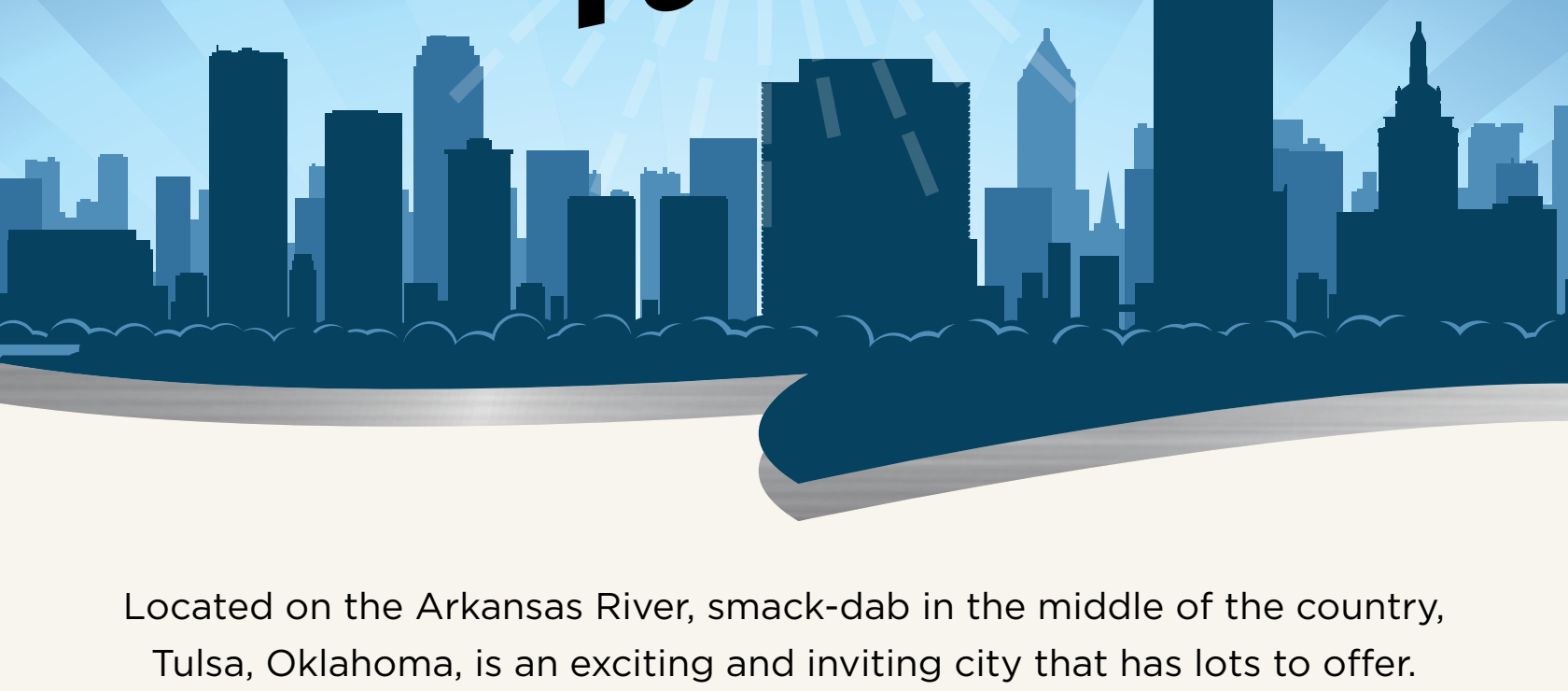


COOL THINGS TO DO IN TULSA

Steak enthusiasts will never forgive themselves if they don't have a meal here during their time in Tulsa.

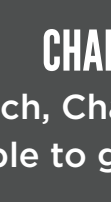


REDROCK CANYON GRILL

SMOKE. WOODFIRE GRILL

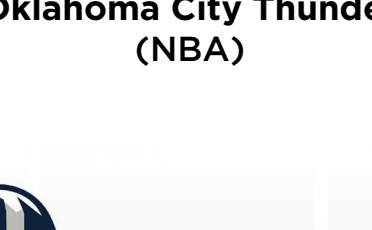
Locally sourced beef makes for a dining experience you'll be talking about for the foreseeable future.



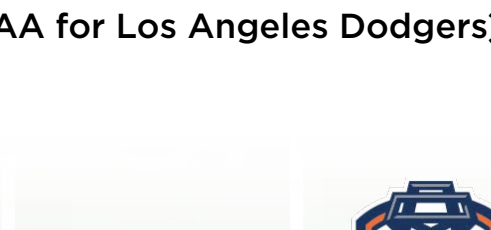
CHARLESTON'S RESTAURANT

After you're full, it's time to head over to a **SPORTING ARENA** in the area to take in a game:



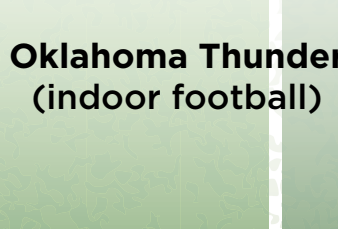

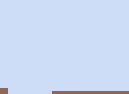
Tulsa is home to an impressive number of museums and similar points of interest, so you'll feel right at home:



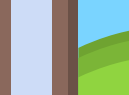

TULSA IS FULL OF ATTRACTIONS THAT EVERYONE WILL LOVE:



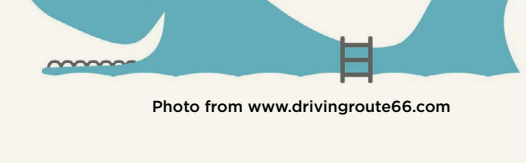
RIVER SPIRIT CASINO: One of Oklahoma's biggest gaming spots is a guaranteed source of entertainment.
