

Women in Skilled Trades Scholarship Program

The Women in Skilled Trades Scholarship Program is a need-based scholarship program that is designed to provide financial assistance to eligible female students with demonstrated financial need. Financial need is based upon the difference between available resources and funding eligibility relative to the direct educational program costs. All prospective/enrolled female students meeting the stated criteria will be eligible for consideration. The criteria have been designed to give the Scholarship Selection Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. The recipient will be selected without regard to race, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- be a female as indicated on the student's Driver's License or government issued ID;
- be enrolled in a program at any Tulsa Welding School campus;
- be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- apply for and accept all applicable state, agency, and/or federal student aid;
- demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid application process;
- complete a Scholarship Request Form; and
- have no lapse in registration or break in attendance.

Award Process and Rules

- Female students who are enrolled at any Tulsa Welding School campus are eligible to apply.
- Students must apply for and accept all available agency, state, and/or federal student aid before requesting consideration for this scholarship program.
- Each student must complete a Scholarship Request Form.
- Scholarships are based on demonstrated need as identified through the financial aid application process.
- Only one award from this scholarship program will be given per student.
- Scholarships will be distributed incrementally over the 2nd half of the student's academic year.
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date or shift, the scholarship award may be forfeited. Scholarships are not transferable or renewable. This scholarship may be used in conjunction with other institutional scholarship programs, but cannot exceed the direct educational program costs.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarship award amount will not exceed \$3,000.

**All scholarship amounts are calculated based on demonstrated need and determined by established guidelines. Please contact your Financial Aid Advisor to discuss options. StrataTech Education Group reserves the right to cancel a scholarship program at any time. However, all scholarships that have been awarded will be honored provided the student continues to meet eligibility.*

Our Policy

Any student meeting the scholarship criteria may apply. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. This scholarship is not transferrable. It will be applied incrementally to the student's account over the 2nd half of the student's academic year. The maximum award for this scholarship program is \$3,000.

Students must complete this request form and submit it with their Driver's License or government issued identification card to the Scholarship Selection Committee to be considered. Of the requests received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those eligible requests, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

This scholarship program is based on the enrolled student's start date. There is a limited number of scholarships to be awarded per institution. If a student changes their start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited.
